- 2-D artwork may not exceed 18"x24"

- Each entry must be labeled with name, home phone #, address, parent's e-mail address, grade, school and **brief description or title**.

5. **Judging criteria:** All entries will be judged by professional artists and will be based on originality, representation and relevance to the theme. All decisions are final.

6. **Categories:** K-5th grades; 6th – 8th grades; 9th - 12th grades.

7. **Date and location:** all artwork must be submitted no later than **Monday, Feb. 27, 2017** through art teacher. Selected artwork will be displayed at the **Herricks Community center Art Gallery** from: **Friday, March 3rd** to **Wednesday, March 29th 2017**. Winners will be notified the week of **March 4th**. Award reception and ceremony: **Thursday, March 16th 2017 at the Herricks Community center**, 999 Herricks road, New Hyde Park, NY 516-248-3100 Winner (only) art works will display at **Manhasset Public Library** from **Saturday, April 1 to Monday, May 29, 2017**. Reception at **MPL on Saturday, April 1st, 2017**.
